



Share your love with the resident men of the State Correctional Institution at Vacaville, CA who will soon be making a Kairos weekend. Kairos is a volunteer ministry bringing Christian community to prisons by forming small "prayer and share" groups within the institutions. This process starts with a 3-day short course on Christianity presented by a volunteer group of laity and clergy.

*You and your church community can help by making hands. Draw the outline of your hand on a piece of colored paper. ** Hand print a brief, one sentence expression of love within the outline of your hand, and sign your first name only. Please do not use stickers, glitter, or glue. Markers, crayons and rubber stamps may be used. Finally, cut out the hands: Everyone, adult and child is encouraged to participate. These hand made expressions of love from you help the residents understand that people out there are concerned about them and they are part of a larger community in Christ.

* The hands will be strung together and hung all around the chapel.
